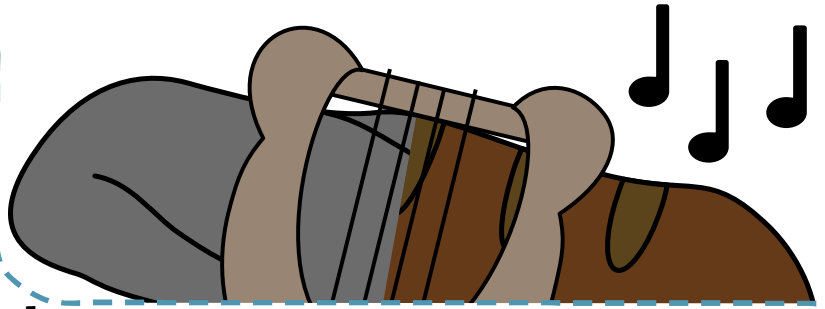

Using the Family Material



How to teach using this pack

The aim of this weekly material is to provide a simple link to the passages used during the Sunday teaching sessions. It links with the lectionary readings for Year B but can be used separately.

- 1 Prepare by spending a moment to recognise everyone there and remind them this is our time to learn about God.
- 2 Read the passage and use the discussion prompts to have a conversation about what you have read.
- 3 Choose an activity to do in response. There is 3 suggestions for whole family activities plus a craft and worksheet.
- 4 Revisit the material through your week, perhaps use the prayer or key verse at mealtimes.

Discussion Prompts

Age differentiated guided discussions about the passage. Preschool, kids and teens.

PRAY

A simple prayer to say with your child

Family Activities

Simple games or activities to build on the ideas or start discussions.

COLOURING PAGE

A colouring picture detailed enough for older kids but still good for younger ones.

Each week get a tiny part of the picture that builds into a bigger scene.

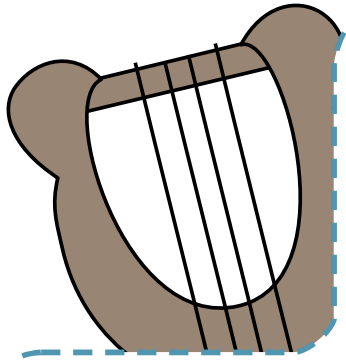

Discussion Prompts

You will need a bible - it doesn't matter which translation you use!

This week we are reading the first 10 verses of Psalm 25. Read it as a family, choose your favourite phrases.

Preschool:

This psalm is a song of praise. What does praise mean? How do we praise? What can we praise God for? It is also about families. Who is in your family? Take a few moments to thank God for each member of your family adding an attribute. (Example: Thank God for grandma's big heart of love.)

Kids :

How do you praise God? Why do you praise God? Do you praise God with your family? Does everyone praise God the same way? Do you think it's possible for babies to praise God? Do you ever praise God during your journeys like the Israelite's did? Choose a line of the psalm and make up a tune for it.

Teens : Look at the psalm. What does the word 'fear' mean in verse 23? This psalm is about praise but it's a two way process, it talks about being heard, eating, seeking, and more. Go through the psalm and circle the actions. Is your praise of God something that results in actions? This psalm talks about God having kingship / dominion; what does that mean? What does it mean to say Jesus had kingship/dominion?

FAMILY ACTIVITIES

The big band - turn your family into a band, if you have no instruments use pots pans, plastic bottles, containers to shake.

Legacy - Talk about your family, trace back your family tree. Can you trace back your faith tree too? How did your family come to know Christ? Take some time to thank those who shaped your faith.

Journey music - Add some christian worship music to a journey you take this week. You could sing a song on your walk, play something in the car, or just hum a tune during your weekly shop. Praise God in a place you may not usually do so.

pencil, scissors, glue.



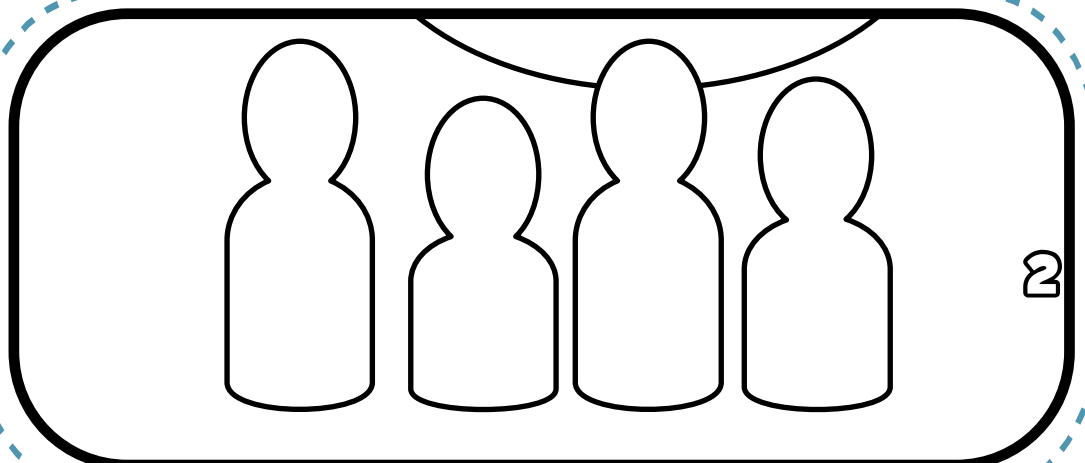
PRAY

Cut out the hand-prints.

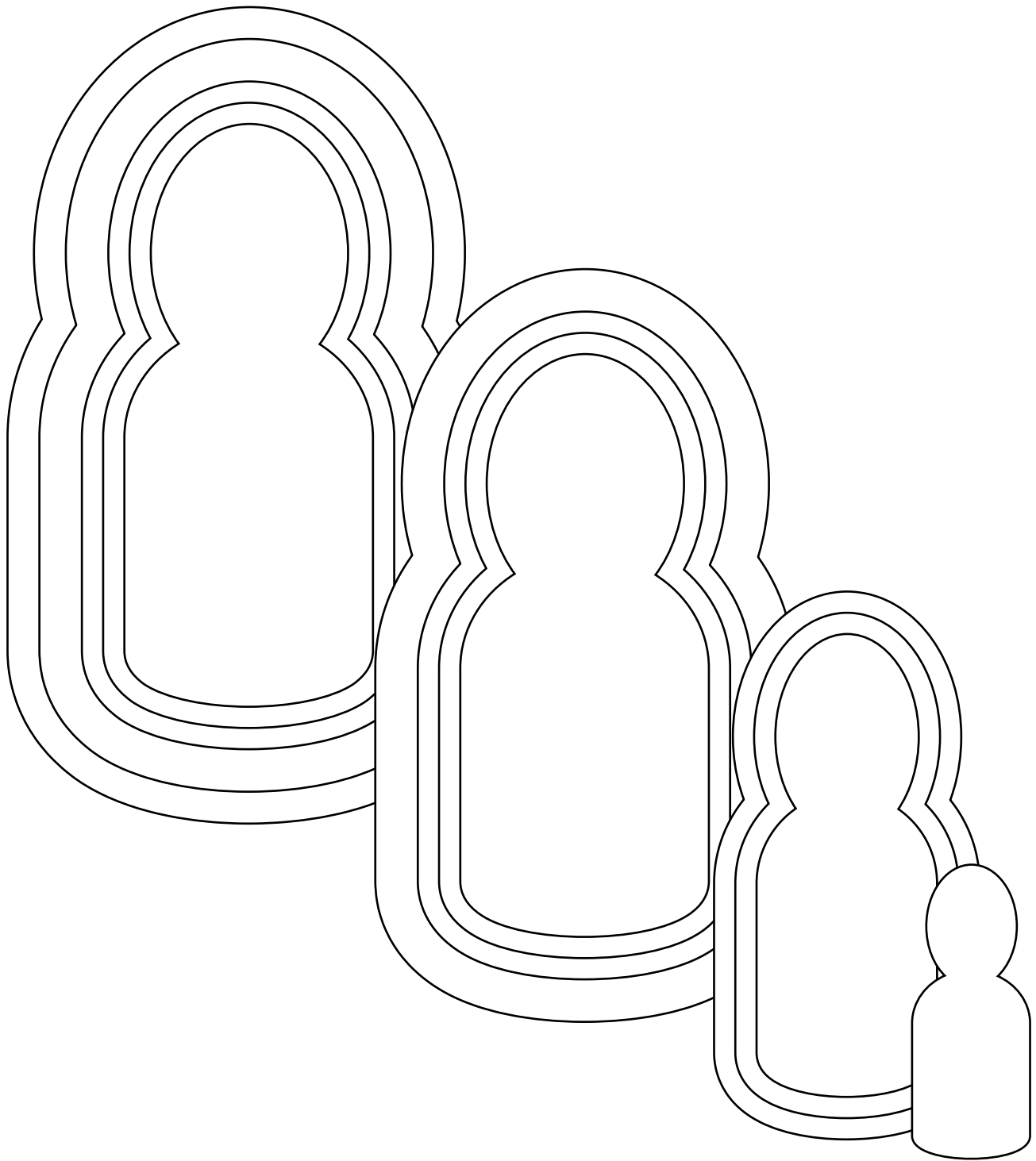
Layer the hand-prints on the white paper.
