

60-Minute Lesson Plan: *The Wedding at Cana* (John 2:1–12)

Time	Activity	Description & Teaching Notes
0:00–0:05 (5 min)	Welcome & Introduction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Welcome the children warmly. Start PPT - Ask: “Who has been to a wedding before? What was it like?” - Explain: “Today, we’ll learn about a wedding Jesus attended where something amazing happened!”
0:05–0:15 (10 min)	Icebreaker Game – “Dress the Bride” 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Divide into groups of 4–5. Give each a roll of toilet paper. - One volunteer becomes the “bride,” and the rest decorate them! - Award prizes for the funniest or most creative “bride.” - Transition: “Weddings are joyful! Today’s story is about a wedding where Jesus brought even <i>more joy!</i>”
0:15–0:35 (20 min)	Story Time via PowerPoint – “The Wedding at Cana”	<p>Tell the Story via PowerPoint. Read from the notes and add your spin on it.</p>
0:35–0:45 (10 min)	Quiz Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use the questions on the PPT - Let children answer in teams — cheer and celebrate each correct answer!
0:45–0:50 (5 min)	Snack & Chat Time 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Offer biscuits and juice. - Chat casually: “What part of the story surprised you most?” - Play soft worship music or background of “Running Over” while they snack.
0:50–0:55 (5 min)	Colouring Page	- provide felt tips
